Camp Sikorsky 2022 – in person! *

A tent camping weekend of career exploration for 200 Girl Scouts and Scouts BSA

In order to comply with the State of Connecticut, Lockheed Martin, Boy Scouts of America and Girl Scouts of Connecticut guidelines, COVID-19 vaccines are strongly encouraged but not required for this event. Campers will be required to self-attest, including the signature of a parent on the registration form, that they have not exhibited symptoms of COVID-19 in the 48 hours leading up to the event OR show a vaccination card. Attendance will be taken and this data will be tracked for contact tracing purposes. Proper safety and health measures will be taken to ensure a safe, healthy, and happy experience for all. *Subject to conversion to virtual pending local regulations.

Eligibility:

Girl Scouts ages 12 and older may register as troops or individually with a parent/legal guardian. **2 registered**, **approved adults are required per troop**, **however**, **to allow for as many girls as possible**, **no more than 2 adults will be permitted**. One adult per troop must have **Out and About** training. Every effort will be made to accommodate girls with disabilities.

Camp Sikorsky is open to U.S. citizens and green card holders only. Green Card holders must provide Green Card # and country of origin.

Note - Tents required for camping; appropriate training required (see above)

Cost:

\$50.00 for girls and adults (must be registered Girl Scouts), if paid by August 15. Includes workshops, meals (Friday snack, all meals on Saturday, and Sunday breakfast), and Camp Sikorsky patch. The fee is \$60.00 after August 15, 2022 and for out-of-Council participants. After August 15, Girl Scouts may register until event has reached capacity.
